Mayor Pro Tempore Jones presided and called the meeting to order after which Councilman Anderson led the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Councilman Powell moved that the minutes from the previous council meeting of March 21, 2006, be approved. Councilman Cotton seconded the motion, which was approved unanimously.

COUNCIL APPROVES TO PAY AUBURN UNIVERSITY INVOICE:

Mayor Pro Tempore Jones presented a bill from Auburn University to the council, for personnel services, in the amount of \$6550. He added that the utility board had agreed to pay half of the bill, which would leave the city owing the remaining \$3275. Councilman Cotton moved to pay the bill from contingency. Councilman Powell seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

COUNCIL APPROVES TO PAY LIGHTING EXPENSE OF THE VETERANS' MEMORIAL:

Mayor Pro Tempore Jones read a memo from the mayor to the council explaining that the Veteran's Memorial Committee had brought to his attention that the city was billing the committee for lighting the Veteran's Memorial Park behind city hall. Councilman Powell, also a member of the Veteran's Committee, said that the committee had other expenses and hoped that the city could absorb the lighting costs along with other maintenance costs. Councilman Anderson moved to pay the lighting expenses of the park. Councilman Alexander seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
