1. That Earl Johnson received a majority of the votes cast for the office of **Mayor** and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2008.
2. That Will Sconiers received a majority of the votes cast for the office of **Councilmember, District One**, and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2008.
3. That Kenneth C. Mount received a majority of the votes cast for the office of **Councilmember, District Two**, and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2008.
4. That Hazel Griffin received a majority of the votes cast for the office of **Councilmember, District Three**, and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2008.
5. That no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of **Councilmember, District Four**, and that Don Cotton and Jason Jewel received the most and second most votes cast for that office, therefore, a runoff election between said candidates is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday, October 7, 2008, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-20 et seq., of the Alabama Code of 1975, as amended.
6. That Terry Powell received a majority of the votes cast for the office of **Councilmember, District Five**, and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2008.
