**COUNCIL APPROPRIATES \$129,360.00 FROM THE GAS TAX ACCOUNTS TO COVER EXPENSE OF RESURFACING FOR THE FEGAN AVENUE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROJECT:**

Mayor Johnson called the meeting to order and explained to the council that the Community Development Block Grant Project to rehabilitate water, sewer and storm water on and around Fegan Avenue was nearing completion and that there was an alternate for additional resurfacing in the contract.
